

# H Drive Desktop Icon No Longer Works

## Problem

A shortcut on a user's computer desktop is links to the H: drive, but no longer works properly.

## Solution

1. Right-click on the Desktop shortcut.
2. Select Properties
  - a. The target field will probably read: \\storage\Home\*username* \*
3. Change the target field to point to the correct location.
  - a. For Staff: \\homestead\STAFF\_HOME\*username* \*
  - b. For Faculty and Retirees: \\homestead\FAC\_HOME\*username* \*
4. Click OK and the shortcut will now point to the correct location.

\*Use your ValpoNet password where the word *username* is indicated above.
